Kivland has haunted the Freud Museums in London and Vienna, as though lingering improperly and listening at doors – an alien guest. In this book she gives her readers a glimpse of how one might find more than a petrified spectre of psychoanalysis on the sites of its history. Adept in ventriloquism and other uncanny tricks, she offers a buyer's guide to some of the dwelling-places of psychoanalysis, whilst reminding the reader that the ego is not master in its own house.
