





## Penelope Slinger // Hear What I Say

Hear What I Say features the British artist's photo-collages shown in London from 1971-1977. Slinger began making 'women's collage' at a point when the medium seemed to have done its thing, most of its original practitioners having abandoned the format. Making collages, montages and 3D works "from a woman's perspective' creates a theatrical atmosphere more akin to film and performance than one dimensional flat art. After more than thirty years AWOL the collages were rediscovered when they reappeared in the Tate exhibition, The Dark Monarch, (2010) about the 'darkness' inherent in much British Art ancient and modern. Slinger's own re-appearance in 2010 came with a critical re-appraisal and rave reviews from curators and art press.

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
